Associate Conductor Daniel Black will lead the orchestra in Tchaikovsky's *1812 Overture*, John Williams's *Summon the Heroes*, Unger's *Ashokan Farewell*, a medley of American marches, and much more.

“These concerts allow us to offer a small token of appreciation to our armed forces and to bring the community together with a selection of music that most people know and love,” said Daniel Black. “It's important for the orchestra to maintain an active presence outside of Bass Performance Hall, and I think the Symphony does an excellent job of bringing these sorts of community programs to the public.”
